UNIFORM POLICY

Enrolment into the School is dependent upon students and parents complying with this policy.

Any student wishing to seek exemption from/modification of the uniform is required to make written application to the School Council outlining the grounds of their request and any approved modifications must be purchased from the school uniform supplier.

Application

- It is expected that all students wear the blazer to and from school. In extreme heat, it will be acceptable for girls to wear the dress and for boys to wear the shirt, tie & trousers without the blazer home from school.
- Jumpers cannot be worn to and from school without a blazer.
- In extreme heat, the tie may be removed on arrival to school. Students will be notified on the day.
- Boys have the option of short or long sleeve shirts.

Application

• In 2015 all students must wear the AHS uniform. The uniform is unique to the school and must be purchased through the school uniform shop. Sporting garments from other stores are not permitted to be worn. Students are permitted to wear the Hijab or head scarf in the school colour of red or white.

It should be noted that a student's general appearance, including hairstyle and jewellery, should be appropriate to the school environment and comply with Occupational Health and Safety requirements. Extremes in a student's appearance which contravene this policy are unacceptable. The determination on these matters will be at the discretion of the Administration.

Breaches of the Uniform Policy

Student Responsibilities

On arrival to school, students out of uniform must report to their Tutor Group teacher. If students are out of uniform they should have a note from their parent/guardian. This note must be given to the student's Tutor Group teacher before school and a pass will be provided for that day (or longer if needed).

All out of uniform breaches will be recorded on Compass by the tutor group teacher. Students who are out of uniform three times without a parent note, will receive an after-school detention.

If this is a regular occurrence this will be referred to the Year level coordinators (sub school manager).

If a student misses Tutor Group, then the teacher in their first class of the day will send the student to the AP office to receive a uniform pass. Students may be asked to change into a spare uniform. Students who continually are out of uniform will be sent home to change when they transgress. Parents will be notified when this occurs. If a student's attire is not appropriate they might be asked to go home to change.

Students who are observed changing into the uniform on entry to school or out of the uniform on leaving school will be given a warning and recorded on Compass. Students who are warned three times will be given an after school detention.

Parent Responsibilities

- Please ensure your child has the correct uniform from the first day, including school shoes.
- Please ensure your child leaves home wearing the uniform correctly: e.g. black school shoes, the blazer etc.
- In some cases, students may spend time between the homes of both parents. Please ensure that the school uniform is packed including school shoes if this occurs on weekends.
- If you are experiencing financial hardship re purchasing items of uniform, please contact the Student Wellbeing Co-ordinator: Carla De Pietro on 9804 6314.

Teacher Responsibilities

- All teachers are expected to actively support School Council's policy on the wearing of the new uniform.
- All Tutor Group teachers are required to put any transgressions on Compass. They will issue afterschool detentions for any of their students who have transgressed three times.
